

CORONAVIRUS : Cancellation of in-person classes as of March 16



In order to best protect the entire population and to take into account the evolution of the COVID-19 epidemic, the President of the Republic announced yesterday evening a series of measures, including the closure to the public of all higher education institutions as of Monday 16 March 2020.

As a result, access to all buildings on all UPPA campuses is no longer permitted to any students, users and other members of the public until further notice.

In order to guarantee pedagogical continuity, the UPPA will ensure that their teaching modules are offered via e-learning (the UPPA's E-Learn platform) in order to enable students to take their courses at a distance. The professors in charge of training and the management of the colleges will send you the relevant information as of next week.
